Building an inclusive brand

Indecent's collection of adult toys have been designed to ensure that sight impaired persons within our community are also able to use our products with ease. LED lights have not been included in any Indecent toy, instead all of our products have proudly been designed with Vibrating Charge Echnology (VCT).

How does VCT work?

Vibrating Charge Technology allows the use of touch over sight when charging your toy. When the adult toy is placed on charged, it will vibrate (pulse) to indicate charging has started. When fully charged the toy will begin to vibrate. The vibration will continue every 5-10 seconds until the toy is removed from its power source.

Key points to follow before using Kinki

Important

- 1. Read this user manual from start to finish.
- 2. Place Kinki on charge. Refer to Charging the Kinki.
- 3. Allow Kinki to fully charge. Initial charge may take up to 1.5 hours.
- 4. Register Kinki by visiting www.indecent.com.au
- Clean and sanitise Kinki before and after each use with specially formulated Indecent Antibacterial Mist.
- After initial charge Kinki may take up to 1 hour to recharge. When power of Kinki is insufficient it will automatically turn off.
- Kinki can be charged as needed. The battery doesn't need to be depleted before charging. Only charge with USB cable provided using a trusted USB port.
- 8. For safety reasons Indecent toys will not operate while on charge.

Charging Kinki

When charging ensure Kinki and USB charging cable is free from water and lubricant.

1. Gently insert charging cable into Kinki



Plug USB charging cable into USB port. Kinki will vibrate (pulse) to indicate charging has started.



Once fully charged Kinki will begin to vibrate (pulse).



 Vibration will continue every 5-10 seconds until removed from charging cable.



Using Kinki

- Hold down Power Button for 2 seconds to turn On/Off.
- Once turned on, Kinki will begin on the first speed. Press Power Button to use second speed. Repeat to use third speed.
- Press the Power Button past the third speed to change Vibration Mode. Continue to press Power Button to scroll through 4 Vibration Modes.
- Use with Indecent Water Based Toy Lubricant for maximum enjoyment.
- When using Kinki take care and be aware of Kinki positioning at all times.

Cleaning, Storage and Safety Information

- All Indecent toys are made using RoHS tested Silicone. For aesthetic enhancement some toy designs may include ABS plastic.
- · Take care when using your toy for the first time.
- Clean your toy before and after each use with specially formulated Indecent Antibacterial Mist and allow to air dry.
- For a thorough clean carefully wash toy with soapy water, rinse, and then spray all over silicone areas with Indecent Antibacterial Mist and allow to air dry.
- If there is an excess of Antibacterial Mist on the toy use a clean soft cloth to wipe off.
- Do not use alcohol based products or undiluted detergents as this may damage the surface of your toy.
- Store your toy in the Indecent storage bag provided, as contact with plastic bags or other vibrators may cause damage to its surface.
- All Indecent toys are designed to be used with Indecent Water Based Toy Lubricant only as other lubricants may cause damage to its surface. This will compromise the toy quality and may void your warranty.
- DO NOT use silicone based lubricants on any Indecent Toy.

Rechargeable toys only

- Vibrating toys are electrical and motors may become warm with use. If you feel your toy is getting unduly warm, switch off and allow it to cool down.
- Take care when cleaning your toy, remember it is an electrical item and moisture can damage your toy.
- Be aware of water exposure to charging sockets/magnet plates when cleaning your toy, we recommend covering the sockets/ magnetic plate with you finger while cleaning to minimise contact with excess water.
- Always allow your toy to cool down before storing in the Indecent storage bag provided.
- When charging this product ensure USB port/wall adapter/wall charger you use is approved and compliant with your country's electrical guidelines.
- Indecent will not be held liable for loss or damage suffered from using non-approved, non-compliant charging port/products. To check whether your product is registered please visit the ERAC government website.
- Indecent toys are water resistant and safe to use when in contact with water.
- Indedent toys are water (splash) resistant. Do not submerge your toys in water. Toys no longer operational due to water damage are not covered under warranty.
